All time hath full provision.*

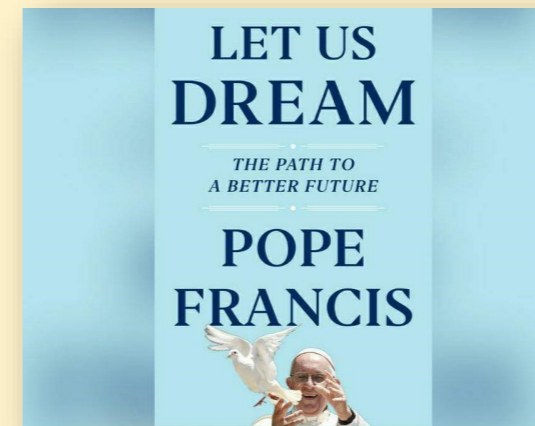
*Then rest: until
