
The Relics of St Bernadette in Lourdes




Family Ramble This Sunday 31st July 2pm



The Folk Group are holding a **Folk Night on Saturday 10th September** to raise money for Alain Kimolo's Education
Project in the Democratic Republic of Congo. Alain was an Asylum
Seeker who lived in St Cuthbert's Parish. On his return to the DRC
he set up a project to help fund children through one school
year. Most of the children helped through the scheme continued
with their education when the financial assistance ended. Three of
the children who were first supported are now studying at
university level.

Because of the pandemic, we have not been able to fundraise for Alain and this year he has been supporting three children through school from his own means. After the St Patrick's night we sent the proceeds from the raffle which, with some donations, came to £200. Alain wrote 'The aid we have just received will help to pay the third term fees for one of these 3 students. We take this opportunity to express our gratitude and our sincere appreciation the whole parish.'
