St Vincent de Paul Society (SVP)

Our Parish group is one of over 800 such groups in England and Wales. Many Schools and Parishes have "Mini Vinnie" or Youth SVP groups. The Parish groups focus on befriending and visiting individuals and families in any sort of

In the past year we had income of £1922 from individual and parish donations and £470 from member giving. We spent £2120 on material assistance to families.

The SVP groups in the Diocese organise a summer Activity Holiday Camp for 40 children from low-income families. We gave £300 towards the cost of sending 6 local children to the Camp in August 2023.

Around the country the Society also runs a number of major permanent projects –

Community Support Centres, Holiday Camps for children, Furniture redistribution outlets and Food Clubs.

The SVP in England & Wales has a "twinning" relationship with SVP groups in India and also Sudan.

Our Parish group is twinned with Southern Sudan and we forward £150 each year as a small help for the SVP work in that troubled country.
