Pope Francis announces first World Children's Day

Pope Francis has announced that the first World Children's Day will take place on 25th/26th May 2024.

A World Children's Day, in the wake of World Youth Day, will be held in Rome on 25-26 May 2024. Pope Francis made the announcement, "with joy", at the Angelus on the feast of the Immaculate Conception.

The initiative responds to the question, "What kind of world do we want to leave to the children who are growing up now? Like Jesus, we want to put children at the centre and care for them".

The event, will see thousands of boys and girls from all over the world flock to Rome.

The idea of a Day entirely dedicated to the youngest among us had been proposed to the Pope last July by a child, 9-year-old Alessandro, on the occasion of the Pope cast, the second podcast made by Vatican Media with Pope Francis prior to the WYD in Lisbon.

"I like it very much!" the Pope replied after listening to the voice message. "We can have it organized by the grandparents. A beautiful idea. I will think about it and see how to do it."

Here is a small extract from The Pope's recent Letter:

I want to speak to each of you, dear children, because, as the Bible teaches us, and as Jesus showed so often, "you are precious" in God's eyes...

Please go to our website to read in full Pope Francis' letter to all children. Please pray Pope Francis' prayer for the children of our Parish and our Parish Schools and for children everywhere:

*Come, Holy Spirit,
show us your beauty,
reflected in the faces
of children all over the world.
Come, Jesus,
you who make all things new,
who are the way that leads us to the Father,
come and remain with us always. Amen. (Pope Francis)*
