

- To get the best out of the day, try to stay for the whole day ( we know this isn't always possible)




Tea & Coffee will usually be served after the 9.30 am Mass at St Joseph & 11.15 am Sunday Mass at St Thomas of Canterbury Church.

### MENU FOOD CHOICES STARTERS

Sweet potato, butternut squash and red pepper soup

or

Stuffed Mushroom with vegetables and soft cream cheese with a fresh herb crust, served on a toasted croute with wild rocket

#### MAIN

Chicken supreme with a Shallot, white wine and cream sauce; or

Vegetable Lasagne, Layers of green pasta filled with vegetables & tomato sauce topped with cheese sauce (v) or Oven baked Salmon Fillet served on a bed of wilted greens, Glazed with a mango sauce and toasted coconut
