Sweet potato, butternut squash and red pepper soup

or

Stuffed Mushroom with vegetables  
and soft cream cheese with a fresh herb crust,  
served on a toasted croustade with wild rocket

#### **MAIN**

Chicken supreme with a Shallot, white wine and cream sauce;

or

Vegetable Lasagne, Layers of green pasta filled with vegetables &
